Pre-Worship

Guidelines for Worship Participants/Seating for Worship

- When you enter the church lawn and until you find your seat, please wear a mask. If you do not have a mask, there will be some available on the worship information table
- Offering will be deposited at the Worship Information Table at the beginning of the brick path. No offering will be collected during worship.
- Bulletins will be provided at the Worship Information Table, but it is highly encouraged to download the bulletin for your mobile devise
- Communion elements will be provided at the Worship Information Table so pick them up before you take a seat. No Communion elements will be served during the worship.
- Worship participants are only required to wear a mask when moving around the worship space and when singing. However, worship participants are encouraged to wear a mask at all times.
- Once you have found your seat for worship, please remain in your space until the end of the service.
- Worship participants are encouraged to leave seats closer to the front and on the pavilion floor for those who need the solid surface to get around or have difficulty hearing.
- A space will be designated for families, should they choose to use it, that will allow space for children to move around.
- When finding your seat do your best to stay six feet from people and wear a mask.

During the Worship Service

- Remain in your designated area for the service
- Offering and communion elements should be picked up before finding your seat –
 there will be no serving of elements or passing the offering plate during the
 service.
- During the life of the church no microphone will be passed. If you feel you are unable to share your news without a microphone, let an usher know and the elder of the day or the pastor will come and write down your news to announce.
- We ask that you avoid the use of the public facilities in the church building if possible. In the case of emergency, please make your way to the restrooms in Trinity Hall. A mask must be worn when in the church building.

Post-worship

• Exiting the Worship Space

- the brick walkway and path will the main way of leaving worship. Keep clear of this area if you are socializing.
- Masks should be worn when exiting the worship area.

• Post worship Socialization

- Always assume that other people don't want you close to them. Keep six feet from people.
- Masks should be worn when moving around the church lawn and worship area
- o If able move out from under the pavilion, please do

Final thoughts

- if there is rain in the forecast during worship, we will be worshiping online. This will be decided and shared by the Friday
- Guidelines will change and reform as time moves on
- if these guidelines are meant with disregard by most people even after being reminded to follow them will lead to moving worship back to an online format
